Seisiún Eolais do Ghnólachtaí agus Seirbhísí i nGaeltacht Iorrais

Is eagrais é Gaillimh le Gaeilge a cuireadh ar bun i 1987 chun úsáid na Gaeilge i gcathair na Gaillimhe a chur chun cinn go mórmhór i measc réimse an ghnó.
